### **Hit-A-Thon**

After pictures, teams will move directly to the Hit-A-Thon, where each child on the team will hit from a batting tee for distance. We will record your child's longest hit on the Hit-A-Thon form (your coach will distribute these shortly if you don't already have them), and that distance will apply to all "per foot" pledges. You don't need to collect any money; just complete the contact information and pledge amounts on the form provided by your coach and we'll take it from there. We are targeting \$100 in pledges per player, so please do your best to fill those pledge cards! We will have some great prizes for our top fund raisers:
