Youth Umpire Application

Thank you for your interest in becoming a youth umpire for Foster City Youth Softball (FCYSA). Our goal is to supply the 10U division with well-trained, mature, and committed umpires for our softball games. The spring season starts late February and ends late May. Umpires can sign up for games on the league umpire site that meet their schedule.

In order to become a youth umpire, you must:

- Be 14 – 18 years old
- Have softball or baseball experience
- Go through umpire training provided by the league
- Shadow an adult umpire in two training games before getting your first umpire assignment

Youth umpires start as field umpires and work their way up to plate umpire based on ability as well as coach and chief umpire feedback. Youth umpires are paid:

\$18 per game as a field umpire

\$25 per game as a plate umpire

Umpires are paid once at the end of the season. You can choose to receive two hours of community service per game instead of being paid.

If you would like to be considered for a youth umpire position, please fill out the application below and mail it to the address indicated. Based upon response, we will invite as many youths as possible to become FCYSA umpires.

Umpires will be selected based on baseball and softball knowledge, temperament, and maturity.
